2015 OFFICER NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS

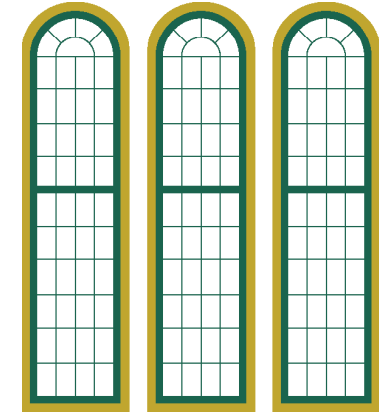
