## THE STATEMENT OF FAITH

Westminster Confession of Faith  
(Chapter 8: *Christ the Mediator*)

The Son of God, the second person of the Trinity, being truly and eternally God, of one substance and equal with the Father, did, when the fullness of time had come, take upon Himself man's nature, with all its essential properties and common frailties, yet without sin. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit in the womb of the virgin Mary and of her substance. 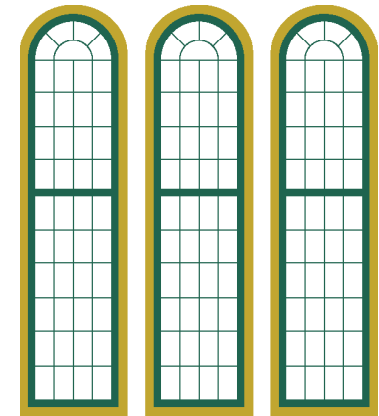
